
Unpacking:

Owner's guide

Unpack the shipping carton carefully, saving the carton and all packaging materials for possible later use. Check carefully to assure your product is not damaged and all accessories are included. If your product appears to be damaged or missing, please do not use it and contact RazTech Lighting immediately.

Raztech Lighting recommends the installation technician be a qualified electrician. This product must be earthed. Do not make any inflammable liquids, water, or metal objects enter this unit.

Very hot lamp. disconnect the power and wait for at least 10 minutes before you can replace the lamp.

Make sure the fan and the air inlets are clean and not blocked by anything before using.

Do not operate this unit if the ambient temperature (Ta) exceeds 40 degrees C (104 degrees F).

Do not stare directly into the light, as may do harm to your eyes.

Keep all flammable materials at least 1 meter away from this unit.

Never operate this unit when its cover is removed.

Keep this unit out of reach of children.

Do not dismantle or modify the unit.

Unplug the fixture from the AC outlet and allow the fixture to cool before any service.



Never disconnect or reconnect the power frequently during operation, this will shorten the lamp life. Wait at least 10 minutes to cool down the lamp completely before restarting this unit. (The warm lamp will cause the igniter holding the lamp to be in a glow state.) The hatch on the Lighting unit is equipt with a switch that will disable power to the unit if hatch in not secured.

Raz300 is a modular system designed specially for image presentations.

Raz300 is fitted with a 300 Watt HTI 300 arc lamp which has a light output of 20,000 lumens at lens.

SIMPLE

This projector is compact, easy to use and entertaining.

SAFE

The low voltage used for the effects eliminates the risk of electric chock. Forced cooling design reduces operating and surface temperature.

STYLING

The projector is elegantly styled, fit in anywhere and runs quietly over long periods with low operating costs.

OPERATION GUIDE

This is a High-Tech product. When you are sure you have set up this unit properly, you can operate this unit freely.

- 1. Always be sure to mount this unit in the area that will allow proper ventilation.
- 2. Check that the local power outlet match that of the required voltage of your unit.
- 3. Plug this unit into the AC outlet, the switch on the Raz300 fixture is normally on.
- 4. The lamp will light slowly and both cooling fans will start immediately.

PREPARATION

FIRST TIME SETUP

- 1. Unpack the shipping container carefully, assemble the accessories to fit in their right positions for proper attachment.
- 2. This unit can be hung or placed in any safe, secure surface by means of its adjustable mounting bracket. With outdoor enclosure mount fixture upright only. Check light beam alignment and adjust with tilt knobs or mounting screws.
- 3. When you are sure this unit is ready for operation, plug this unit into the appropriate AC outlet.

WARNING!!!!

The installation should be done by qualified staff only. Do not obstruct the fan cooling vents.

LENS FOCUSING

- 1. Mount the fixture in your final desired position and make sure the fan vents are not covered.
- 2. Move complete lens assembly along guides for rough focus, see (fig. A).
- 3. Adjust the lens by moving the lens assembly front to back to reach proper focus.
- 4. Tighten the thumb screw after you achieve your desired focus.

Image/Film/Gobo Changing

- 1. Unclip the film holder from the two rods and remove film holder from unit.
- 2. Unclip the image from holder and replace, observe orientation of image when removing.
- 3. Reverse process to install film and film holder.

Lens Assemblies

The are two adjustable lens assemblies on the rails. The lens assemblies can be moved along the rails to focus and zoom. To provide the smallest image size remove one of the lens assemblies and then focus. To provide the largest image size position both lens assemblies with the lenses closest to each other, then focus.

Always wear safety glasses



CLEANING

- 1. Disconnect the fixture from AC power and allow the fixture to cool down completely.
- 2. Use normal glass cleaner and a soft cloth to wipe down the outside casing and external lens.
- 3. Use only soft cloth to clean the internal optics.
- 4. Always be sure to dry all parts completely before plugging in.

LAMP REPLACEMENT

METAL HALIDE LAMP WARNING!!!


This fixture is fitted with a metal halide lamp which is highly susceptible to damage if improperly handled. Do not touch the bulb of the lamp with bare fingers (this can cause damages). The lamp contains small quantities of materials that will be harmful to the environment, please dispose of the damaged lamp properly.

TO REPLACE THE LAMP

Lamps:

- HTÎ 300 W/DX (100V/300W 6500°K 750 hrs) included
- HTI 300 W/DEL (85V/300W 5700°K 3000 hrs)optional
- 1. Disconnect the fixture from power and allow the lamp to cool.
- 2. Loosen the two knurled screws and remove the top cover.
- 3. Loosen the 2 thumb screws from the lamp socket.
- 4. Gently take the old lamp out.
- 5. Replace the new lamp and refit the 2 thumb screws.
- 6. Put in the new lamp securely into the socket.
- 7. Tighten the 2 thumb screws and reassemble in reverse order.

REMEMBER ALWAYS REPLACE WITH THE SAME TYPE LAMP AND FUSE.



FUSE REPLACEMENT

There are five safety features on the Raz300 with enclosure. Three fuses and two thermo cutoff. The Raz300 3 fuses:

- 1.) located in the back of the weather housing
- 2.) located in the back of the fixture housing
- 3.) located within the fixture towards the back

Check all three of the fuses with a ohm meter for a short. A short means that the fuse is ok.

Fuses: 5mm diameter x 20mm long

- 1.) 6.3 amp fuse is located in the housing.
- 2.) .9 amp fuse is located in the Raz300 compartment.
- 3.) 6.3 amp fuse is located in the Weather proof housing.

Thermo-shut down and reset

- 1.) Located in lamp compartment (Auto reset after cool down)
- 2.) Located in weather proof housing (auto reset after cool down)

Changing fuse

- 1. Disconnect the fixture from power.
- 2. With a flat screwdriver wedge the fuse holder out of its housing.
- 3. Remove the old fuse from the holder and replace with the exact same type fuse.
- 4. Replace the fuse holder into the fuse holder housing.
- 5. Reconnect main power
